* **Physical Science, Biology, and Chemistry** are required for the academic diploma. Also, students must have 4 math credits and complete the math sequence through **Algebra II**. However, it is recommended that students continue in math through **Trig/Analysis** or **AP Calculus** if possible. The general diploma requires 3 math credits and students must complete the math sequence through **Geometry**.

**Although only 2 years of a foreign language are required for the academic diploma, it is recommended that students continue in foreign language beyond the 2 required years.

Academic Diploma with Honors

Students choosing the Academic Diploma with Honors program will need to fulfill the following requirements:

1. Satisfy the graduation requirements of the Academic Diploma and have an overall cumulative average of 85% *
2. Earn **two (2) additional credits** in one of the following subject areas: Math, Social Studies, Science, English, and Foreign Language.

OR

3. Fulfill the requirements of the Academic Diploma with an overall cumulative average of 85%* plus earn **four (4)** credits in either Fine Arts or Technology.

Service Hours

GBCS requires 75 service hours for graduation. As a guideline, the breakdown for each grade is listed below:
